More than 20 years ago, when I was young, my family had to flee Russia. They were persecuted for being Christians. I have grown to realize how important it is to share God's love in places around the world that are mostly unreached with the Good News. People need to hear the Bible explained in their language by people who understand their culture and experiences.

I am taking classes that are helping me to learn how to do that. It is important to have schools that will help students, who come from difficult backgrounds, so they can learn the truth about the Bible and that they will understand better who God is.
